Submission Guidelines

Papers: All papers must conform, at time of submission, to the IEEE Formatting Guidelines, and limited to at most 6,500 words, and 10 pages including text, appendices, figures and references. Make sure that you use the MS Word template and the LaTeX class provided on the website. Submission will be accepted via EasyChair at <https://www.easychair.org/conferences/?conf=ict4s2016>.

Proceedings will be published in open access by Atlantis Press.
